# FOOD VENDORS - \$350 full weekend price only

- One vendor space is 10'X10'.
- All vendors are located outside the Event Center West in the adjacent parking lot.
- Must supply own canopy, tables, chairs, generator, extension cords and water supply. Extension cords must be taped down for safety hazard.
- All food vendors must have current food handler permit and displayed.

## ARTS & CRAFTS - \$250 full weekend price only

- The Clearwater River Casino is not responsible for any theft, damaged/lost items or short funds.
- Vendors are responsible for their products at all times.
- The powwow committee wishes to preserve the skill and identity of Native American artisans and requires that all vendors follow the guidelines defined by the Indian Arts & Crafts Act of 2000.
- (1) 8ft table, (2) chairs provided.
- Hooking up to the Clearwater River Casino & Lodge power supply is strictly prohibited.

**Payment**: Processed at Casino Box Office or by phone 208-746-0723. <u>Must be paid in full prior to setup</u>.

Setup: 1pm - 6pm, Friday October 20, 2023. No set up allowed after 6pm Friday October 20, 2023.

Extra tables: Available for \$20 per table and must fit in the assigned space.

All vendors must be open for business by Grand Entry each day.
